The Face Forward program gives court-involved youth between the ages of 14 and 24 a second chance to succeed in the workplace.

The goal is to give young people (with no prior convictions as adults) real opportunities to gain education, job training, and life skills that will pave their way to a productive future.

Face Forward combines legal, education, and job services that empower young people to achieve their personal employment and life goals.

- Assists youth to obtain education and industry-recognized credentials in high-demand occupations and industries and increase long-term labor market prospects.
- Offers case management, GED preparation, occupational skills training, workforce literacy training, job development and mentoring.
- Provides legal assistance, including sealing and expungement of juvenile records, restoring drivers' licenses, creating and/or modifying orders of protection, child support orders, and resolving employment or licensing issues.
